At its heart is Salzburg, birthplace of Mozart and setting for “The Sound of Music”. Our hotel is located in the friendly hamlet of St. Georgen im Attergau, close to Lake Attersee. The wide area with its gently rolling foothills is appealing to both the more physically active and those seeking to relax amidst romance of the unspoiled nature and fabulous scenery.

April 8: Over night flight to Manchester England

April 9: Enjoy the day and evening at leisure to explore Manchester, known as the "city of first's".

April 10: The tour starts today, Kavanagh will pick us up around 2:00 in a luxury coach, we will make our way across England to Hull where we will board the overnight cruise ferry to Zeebrugge, with en-suite cabins, dinner and breakfast included.

April 11: Today we continue through Belgium and Germany, with a lunch stop in Luxembourg City. Our Driver/Guide will give an overview of the city then on to our overnight stop in Karlsruhe. (Dinner, B&B)

April 12: Today we will see Germany, passing the famous cities of Stuttgart, Ulm and Munich before we cross the border into Austria. We arrive at our hotel in St. Georgen im Attergau, where we will check in for the next 5 nights. (Dinner, B&B)

April 13: after breakfast, we drive to Salzburg to spend a full day in the “Sound of Music” city. Set amongst wonderful alpine scenery, Salzburg is one of the best-preserved historic cities in all of Europe. A walking tour with a local guide will show us the main sights then the afternoon is at leisure for you to explore. Perhaps take the funicular up to magnificent Hohensalzburg Fortress, stroll through the Mirabell Gardens – one of the settings for “The Sound of Music” or maybe visit Mozart’s birthplace. We return to the hotel in time to relax before dinner. (Dinner, B&B)

April 14: Today’s excursion takes us around three of the most famous lakes – Mondsee, Attersee and Wolfgangsee. The baroque church at Mondsee was the setting for Maria’s wedding to Captain Von Trapp. Enjoy the dramatic mountain scenery as we drive around the lakes, stopping at various locations including the famous “White Horse Inn” at St. Wolfgang. (Dinner, B&B)

April 15: Today we head south to the village of Hallstatt which clings to the steep slopes of the foothills of the Dachstein Massif. Hallstatt is a photographer’s paradise with many wonderful views and the charming village has many shops, restaurants and cafes. The Chapel of the Skulls is well worth a visit, or you may like to take the funicular railway for fantastic vistas over the lake. (Dinner, B&B)

April 16: Today is at leisure to relax and enjoy the beautiful surroundings. For those who would like to finish last minute shopping our driver will take us to Salzburg for the afternoon. Then back to the hotel for our last Dinner in Austria.

April 17: Today we check out of the hotel and start to retrace our journey back through Germany to our overnight stop in Karlsruhe. (Dinner, B&B)

April 18: Our route takes us back through Belgium to Zeebrugge where we board the overnight cruise ferry to Hull. Relax and enjoy the ship's entertainment as we cruise back to England, with en suite cabins, dinner & breakfast on board.

April 19: after disembarking at Hull, we travel back to Manchester to have an afternoon and evening at leisure.

April 20: allow 3 hours at the airport before your A.M. flight back home.
